Class Descriptions:

Hunter Over Fences: Horses to jump approximately 8-10 fences at the canter (unless a trot is specified). Judged on the horse's pace, jumping form, manners, and style.

Equitation Over Fences: Judged on the rider's ability to negotiate a course of 8-10 fences at the canter (unless a trot is specified), demonstrating correct position, control, and style.

Hunter Under Saddle: Horses to walk, trot and canter. Equine quality of movement, manners, consistency, and hunter type are the main criteria.

Equitation on the Flat: Judged on the rider's position and encompasses a rider's ability to ride correctly and with effective aids. Also judged is the rider's performance and control of the horse, use of riding aids, correct form, and balance.

Hunter Derby: Consists of a jumping course that combines hunter jumps and cross-country elements. There will be approximately 8 efforts on varied terrain, in and outside the arena, that may include (depending on Division level) coops, logs, a liverpool, brush box, small bank and other natural-type obstacles.
