**Classes:** USDF Intro A, B, & C. USEF Training Level 1-3, USEF First Level 1-3, and USEF Second Level 1-3. Prix Caprilli 1, 2, & 3. Dressage equitation.

**Awards:**

- Ribbons thru 6<sup>th</sup> place
- Class High Score prizes
- Overall High Score and Reserve High Score ribbons and prizes

**Entries: Due to COVID-19, entries will be limited.**

Riders must specify their birthdate on the entry form. A negative Coggins test dated within 12 months of show must accompany entry and proof of equine vaccinations.

Post entries may be accepted at the management's discretion with a \$20 office fee. Changes to entries cannot be made after the closing date. No refunds after closing date. A \$10 office fee will be charged for refunds made before closing date. Management reserved the right to combine, divide or cancel classes.

Payment Methods: Check or Credit Cards. Checks payable to The Stables, LLC. Credit card payments will be accepted by directly contacting the Show Manager. Due to COVID-19, entries are preferred by e-mail. E-mail confirmations will be sent. Contact the Show Manager if you do not receive a confirmation. **Entries will not be processed unless payment has been received.**

**Refunds:** If classes are scratched and/or entire entry is withdrawn *by the closing date* in writing to the Show Manager (e-mail is acceptable), a full refund less \$10 office fee will be sent after the show.

**Fees:**

Class Fee	\$15	
Office Fee	\$10	(per horse/rider combination)
Stall Day Fee	\$20	(Saturday a.m. – Saturday 6:00 p.m.)
Overnight Stall Fee	\$30	(Friday p.m. – Saturday 6:00 p.m.)

**Schedule:** Ride times will be posted/e-mailed prior to the show. Classes may not necessarily be run in the order listed in the Prize List.

**Stabling:** No horses are to arrive before 3:00 p.m. on Friday. Stabling in permanent stalls. Limited bedding is provided. Stalls must be stripped before leaving.  
*Stabling information:* Contact the Show Manager

**Paddocks:** Paddocks are for turnout only. Horses in paddocks must not be left unattended. No horses permitted in paddocks overnight. All paddocks must be empty by 6:00 p.m. and not re-opened until 7:00 a.m. each morning.

**Proof of Equine Vaccination:** The Stables Equestrian Center requires that every horse be vaccinated against equine influenza, EH1 and EH4 within 6 months of the show.

**Food/Concessions:** Due to COVID-19, food will not be provided at the show.

**Waiver and Release of Liability:** The Stables, LLC Waiver and Release of Liability form must be signed and submitted with the registration form. If the competitor is a minor, the form must be signed by a legal guardian.

\*If the Waiver and Release of Liability Form and the proof of vaccinations are not submitted prior to or at the time of check-in, the competitor will not receive their competition number and the horse will be asked to lease the grounds.

**Attire:** Riders may wear traditional show attire. Informal attire (short or long-sleeved shirts; no t-shirts, breeches, tall boots or paddock boots with half chaps) also acceptable ASTM/SEI-approved helmets are required for all riders when mounted.

**Bridle Numbers:** Horses must wear a bridle number at all times when out of the stall.

**Readers:** Readers are allowed to call tests. If the a test is called, it is the responsibility of the competitor to arrange for a person to announce the test. Unless an exception is made by the judge, the calling of the test must start with the first movement. Lateness and errors in calling the test will not relieve the rider from “error penalties”. Calling the test is limited to reading the movement as it is written once only. However, the repetition of the reading of a movement is acceptable if there is reason to doubt that the rider heard the original call.

**Announcements/Ring Stewards:** Class and ride-time announcements are provided as a courtesy to the competitors. Competitors are responsible for presenting themselves to the ring at their designated time and accept full responsibility for doing so. Ring stewards will make every reasonable effort to keep competitors and others informed and entering the ring in a timely fashion. Competitors are ultimately responsible for knowing the correct show time and their scheduled ride time, regardless of PA announcements, instructions of the ring stewards, or lack thereof.

**Arenas:** Weather-permitting, all tests will be ridden in the outdoor arena (20m x 60m). In the event of inclement weather, the show will be held in the indoor arena (20m x 40m). All show arenas are on sand. Outdoor warm-up area on grass dressage court.

**Dogs:** No dogs allowed.
